Middlewich Youth Theatre working in conjunction with the Clean Team have started a programme of visits to local schools to promote the importance of the pupils keeping their town clean.

In this unique venture, the pupils are coached by Catherine and Helen from the Youth Theatre (plus members of the Clean Team) to develop a short play about the consequences of littering. This culminates in a performance of four or five scenes involving the consequences of dropping litter and how it effects the environment plus a song that the children write. This is funded by the Clean Team with help from the grant recently obtained for us from the Co-operative Community Fund by our Grants Officer, Stephen Dent.
