Pubwatch and Clean Team join forces to stub out litter

The Clean Team are working closely with JTI, CPRE and Mrs Liz McGuinness of Middlewich Pubwatch to site cigarette stub bins outside public houses in the town in an attempt to cut down on the amount of litter caused by cigarette smokers. Approximately 5 tonnes of smoking-related litter—cigarette butts, matchstick and packets—are dropped every day in the UK.
